How it all started

Having been brought up by an Italian/English family I had a real mixture of cuisines thrown at me growing up. My English mother loved to cook hearty home-made English stews, casseroles, etc., and my Italian Nonna would cook authentic southern Italian family meals such as a variety of pasta dishes, slow-cooked meats, and incredible cakes. The one thing in common was both sides of the family cooked with fresh produce and ingredients and with passion.

Since the age of 3, I remember spending weekends at my Nonna's house, which is where all 20+ family members would gather for a traditional Sunday feast. Every week without fail! My earliest memories are waking up early on a Sunday to the incredible aroma of ragu. Preparations for the feast had already begun! I remember being obsessed with the smells, and I would run to Nonna and ask how she made that sauce smell and taste so good! My passion for cooking had begun, and for years I would linger in the kitchen where my Nonna and Aunties would be running around making magic happen. To be honest, I still do!

Many chefs train in Minori, but one of its most famous is Jamie Oliver, who was mentored by Gennaro Contaldo. Gennaro Contaldo worked alongside my grandfather when he was a chef.

Another famous chef from Minori is Ursula Ferrigno, who is known for food blogging and her amazing Italian cookbooks. Ursula is a member of my family on my Nonna's side.

In 2018, when I met Sophie, everything went "next level." Dating was complicated as Sophie had young children, so we found date night in the van was a great solution. It was time for me to show off my passion for cooking, so regular campervan fine dining it was!



In 2021 we took a huge gamble and despite lockdown in force we decided to plan our very own vanlife food festival. In August luck was on our side as we were the proud hosts of that years UKs favourite Vanlife festival.

400 Vans gathered amongst the stunning scenery of a quaint farm set in the beautiful countryside of Basingstoke.

We showcased all our favourite culinary brands with cooking demos, foraging walks, wellbeing classes, crafting workshops, live music and inspirational travel talks. It was certainly an event to remember!

Our 2021 Festival received over 100'000 YouTube views across multiple influencer channels.

In August 2022 we returned to Dummer Down Farm with an even bigger festival that continued to impress every guest including our TV celebrity chef guest Kwoklyn Wan. **550 guests** joined us for yet another 3 days of culinary fun and van inspiration.

We introduced more cooking workshops, top social media influencers participated in hilarious culinary challenges, more music and more show vans.

Many of the larger influencers are attending and claim Vanlife Eats to be their favourite event of the year.


2024 was our biggest year yet. We sold **700 tickets**, **Early bird tickets sold out in less than 24 hours yet again!**



TikTok has become an exciting platform for us over the past six months. It's proving to be fantastic for sharing quick recipe teasers and sparking conversations about products we use. The channel is growing rapidly, and we're excited to build on this momentum in 2025.
